ACTIVITIES

We're going to be spending the weekend in the beautiful Surrey countryside! We'll go on some walks, have some campfires, play some big games, eat great food and pray for each other. It's going to be loads of fun.

LOCATION

We'll be spending the weekend at the Henman Bunkhouse on Leith Hill (Henman Bunkhouse, Broadmoor, Dorking, RH5 6JZ). The bunkhouse is a quaint 1920's Swiss Chalet style bungalow located on the National Trust's Leith Hill Estate. The bunkhouse has a well equipped kitchen and larder whilst the dining/communal area has a dining table for 12. There are also comfy chairs, and an open fire. The three bedrooms have hand basins and there are plenty of showers.

TRAVEL

We'll be taking a mini bus and maybe a couple of cars with us for the weekend. If you'd like to come with us in the mini bus or cars, we'll be meeting at the **Yvonne Arnaud Theatre** (Millbrook, GU1 3UX) at 6pm on the Friday. Please let me know asap if you'd like to travel there and back with us or if you will be making your own way.

On the Sunday we'll be heading from Henman Bunkhouse straight to SummerFest (Emmaus Rd's annual baptism party) which is at Broadwater Pavilion (Guildford Road, Godalming, GU7 3BU). SummerFest starts at 12pm so we'll aim to arrive for then. Everyone will be free to go home from there. Again, please let me know if you'll be coming with us to SummerFest in the bus/cars or if you'll be making your own arrangements.

ACCOMODATION

Henman Bunkhouse has 16 beds in dormitories, which might mean that a few of us end up camping outside in tents (Emmaus has tents and camp beds which we will bring so no one else needs to). If you would rather not sleep in a tent please let me know, otherwise we'll just work it out on arrival. There is no bedding at the bunkhouse, so everyone needs to bring a sleeping bag and pillow.

FOOD

All of your food for the weekend is included in the price you've paid. If you have any special dietary requirements which you didn't include on your booking form, then please let me know ASAP.

WIFI AND PHONES

There is no WiFi at Henman Bunkhouse and phone reception is not very good, so that will be a challenge for us all! If your parents need to get in touch in an emergency and can't get through due to signal, the landline number for the bunkhouse is 01306 711715.
